And welcome once again everybody to Success left A clue, this is Robert Raymond Riopel and of course I am your host and this is episode number 39.

So, if you have been listening to the episodes in order you'd know that the last couple of episodes I had to be in India while recording them.

This episode is coming to you straight from, no other than my home. I'm in my office right now, recording this next episode and I 'm really excited about it as well. It's funny I'm excited about all of them. Because when I do this I'm using my own clues, my own clues to success, and the biggest when I use is probably write it down, write them down like I mentioned few on podcast. Because when I'm traveling and it's when I am all about I'm watching for the lesson all around, I'm looking for the inspiration, what is I'm going to do my next talk on. And so, that's when this one came up as well. I was thinking back to what is the benefits between me and my life that allowed me to move in forward, and probably one of the most inspirational thing, or one of the thing that I seem to get the most from or seems to take me to another level the quickest, is something called being part of a "Master Mind", master mind and this is a huge clue to success. If you want to be successful, and I talked about it in one of my previous podcast is the 3:1 reach. You want to make sure that you have at least 3 coaches in your life, at least two mentors and be part of at least one mastermind. And if you are, you will end up having wealth in all areas of your life, you are rich not just in happiness, not just in success, but relationships, money, health, all areas of your life.

And so, this episode actually comes directly from something I learnt when I was joining one of my hires in mastermind that I was a student of. Now, let me be clear, and listen close to it. This is not one that am I running, is not that I offered to people, this one as my way of continued learning is one I am part of as a student. And one of the concept that the person that was running mastermind talked about right away is, he wrote down the words givers, game, givers game and then he went through to explain what exactly that means.

The other day, on my way back from India I was thinking about it, I was getting ready because I know one of my mastermind friends were getting ready for an amazing trip to the East coast of the US for a 5 days event. And also, that lesson came to me, and I had to write it down for the talk of one of the podcast. What is giver's game?

Well, let me give you an idea. There's a big difference between success people and people who are unsuccessful or people who struggle. People who struggle are unsuccessful anything they go to, anything they sign up for, anything they join, anything they are going to learn. They have got a mindset of: "What I am going to get out of this?", "How is this going to benefit me?" and that is fine, that is fine to have as a secondary or third kind of believe in your head or question in your mind. Again, only my opinions, take it for what it is worth.

The first thing you want to ask yourself is "How can I contribute?" So especially as an example, when it comes to be part of a mastermind, if you can be part of a master mind, you want to work into where is going, how can you of service to the members, knowing you're going to get stuff out of it, or maybe not every time you will. But you go in from the aspect as "I'm going to be here as a giver, I'm going to open my resources, if you have a great rolodex you open that rolodex.

You are there to assist the other people that are in the mastermind with you. So that one of them is not brain storming, you are not holding back your contacts, you are not holding back.

I'm going to use an example, which some of you may rub you the wrong way, with things that are going on in US with the political situation. But think of Donald Trump and when he was the host of The Apprentice, you will see it over and over again, especially on this celebrity version. He will go to do their fundraisers and you will get some of the celebrities that he was like "I am all in, even if it's not my charity that may benefit from this, if you are doing a fundraiser, I'm all in, I'll call in now all my friends, I will

open my rolodex, I'm here 100%". But the majority of them, you will see all back, your biggest contributors, your biggest contacts for that it was dirtier.

And whether you agree with that or not, whatever, if you notice on the show a lot of the times the ones you held back ended up never receive a full contribute, they were fired early on in the show, or if they did, they were not only, the ones that with benefits will go forward, they opened themselves up fully to help as many of their team mates as they can.

So, same thing in life, if you are learning something and you are with a group of people, how can you assist them in the learning? How can you assist your mastermind members? How can you be there fully for them? Not worried about what you're going to get out of it. And the cool thing that happens when you are the giver, you feel better, which is a gain. You feel awesome because you're helping others, which is a gain, by what you offer notice is that you start to receive, because as you give, other people that law of reciprocity, they are wanting to give back to you. They all want to contribute to you thank you, help you, because you fully helping them.

All of them you want to help? Mayne not. You don't have any anticipation or expectation of what should or should not happen with these people. But watch what will happen?

In my experience, my humble experience, you will see that when you are a true giver, you will see a big gain. And that comes into all areas.

It's the same thing, when you are working with charities. Yes, you hear a lot of time, "Give at least 10%, and give 10%". I'm a big proponent that you give what you can as you can. If you can't give money as you are financially struggling, you give what you can. And your time is as valuable as money. For a lot of people their times is more valuable than the money. So, you give what you can and then how do you create success in your life you can give more. Until a point when it is probably easier to actually give money, so you can still, why not give your time still, and you do it as the giver, knowing that you all read the benefits down the reward, because you have a much more fulfilled life and as you get into more success and you find yourself giving to more and more people, watch, it's like the domino effect.

So now every business that my wife and I start, we look at what charity do we want to benefit right out of the gate, givers, right from the beginning. So that we can benefit to help other people, help animals, help the planet, whatever it is. So, givers gain, ladies and gentlemen.

When it comes from the aspects of what can I give and not worried of what I can get, you will still get, more than you ever imagined. That is the printable of success right there. That is one of the biggest clues that success has left.

So, think like a successful person. Do what a successful person does, and always utilize the givers gain law in your favor.
