

TRANSCRIPT

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[Intro]

Welcome once again everybody. This is Robert Raymond Riopel. Your host of *Success Left A Clue*. And I want to welcome you to Episode Number 47.

This episode here today, I happen to be coming to you, I am in the middle of doing one of my trainings. Hence, I have what is called trainer's voice. I have done two full days of training so far. But when you are inspired, when inspiration hits, you've got to take action. So it doesn't matter that I have been on stage all day. It doesn't matter that I still have a full day to go. I wanted to get this episode recorded, put up and ready to go because inspiration hit me today. So I knew I had to do it. Let me explain what I mean. I happen to be coming to you right now from Dublin, Ireland.

I am doing a 3 day amazing program right now and first time ever in Ireland. The people are blowing me away. The fun I am having, they have the kind of sense of humor that I do. They are amazing, genuine people that are just ready to take their lives to another level. So we're having a good time. And I finished up for the night, I got back to my hotel, I am doing some finishing up. I am doing some paperwork. I am doing some phone calls, business. Coz back home, it is 7 hours behind me. So my night time is their afternoon, which means with a lot of things going on businesswise, there's lots of great things that can be done that I can do. Anyway, put that all sight.

Today's episode is going to be inspired like I have been doing, a number of the podcasts, and I hope you've been enjoying it. Remember, make everything you do, a reflection of you. And I have said that before, and I've been putting in the podcast, that is why in some of the podcasts I use songs to actually be the theme for the talk. And that is exactly same thing that we are going to do right now. Because I was talking to one of my students and I actually even said that to them. Coz we are asking about their podcast. They are new to it. What kind of insights, how to get it out there further. And what I said to her, I found myself saying that, "What do you love? What is it you do? Who are you? Make everything you do a reflection of you. And it made me think, something I have just seen on the internet a little while earlier, so when I got back to my hotel room, the inspiration was hitting, so I found it and I hadn't recorded earlier because the theme song is the song that isn't on iTunes. I couldn't easily find it to be able to record it. So I am going to see enough about that right now. I am going to play the song and then we are going to talk about today's episode. So listen closely. Here it is.

What a beautiful voice! That song is called Dream It Possible. And it is by a Chinese artist called Jane Zhang. And she was on the largest talent contest in the world, which happens to be out of China. And on the final episode, they actually have 400 million viewers watching the finals. Like it is an obsession for people over there to see who the next female voice singer is going to be. And in fact, during this course of the show, 1.2 billion people had voted during the whole series for that season, 400 million viewers. 400 million viewers. Can you imagine that? And so, this young lady, Jane Zhang, she did not actually win but she actually was the one that went on to stardom. And so, I have listened to the song by chance, when one of my students had put it on their Facebook post as their comment to one of the things I put up a while ago. I heard the song. It blew me away. I felt in love with it. But I couldn't find it. Finally, coz I wanted it for an episode, tonight I was so inspired, I made it happen. I found it so that I can put it. Because what is it all about? Dream It Possible. That's what the book *Success Left A Clue* is about.

The first step is dreaming. And not just dreaming, but dream the big dream. Because it is when you dream it that you actually bring it to reality. If you can't see it, you can't conceive it. And I was just teaching this portion yesterday morning, the first day of the course I am teaching, is that people say when I see it, I believe it. But the

opposite is true. It is when you truly believe it, you will actually see it. It is the opposite. You've got to have that belief in your heart. You've got to have that dream, that manifestation, and once you do, you are actually going to be able to create it and connect it and have it be what you want.

Dream it possible. Look, I am going to give you a real world example. The person who did the amazing foreword for my book, the one and only Mamie Brown's baby boy, Les Brown. Him and I are to be connecting because he wants to interview on his Facebook Live for 1.1 whatever million viewers he happens to have. And we've been trying to connect back and forth, back and forth. And so, what happens, I've got it on my mind, I know I am going to make it happen. I know I am going to get the connection. And here I am, I am finishing a business call. I happen to have Facebook app coz we are looking something on it. And all of a sudden, I see that Les is live on it. He is doing live. And I think to myself, "Is he live? Or is this a replay of his live?" They already have 12,000 viewers, 209 shares. Hundreds and hundreds of comments. There is 700 live viewers at that moment. And I am thinking this is awesome. So I am thinking, what can I do? You know what? I decided to take my phone out, pull up my Skype, coz I am in Ireland. He is back in the US. I dialed his number up. It rings, it rings, it rings and then it goes to voicemail.

But all of a sudden, through the recording, coz I am listening at the same time to Facebook, and I heard this *zzzzzzz... zzzzzzz... zzzzzzz...* on his desk. And I was like, "No. Is that really me?" So I dialed again, rings, rings, rings, goes to his voicemail and all of a sudden, you hear this again, *zzzzzzz... zzzzzzz... zzzzzzz...* And I saw Les Brown and I was like, "It is me. It is live. Love it!" I am dreaming this possible. So as soon as I am watching a little bit more, coz he had been interviewed by someone for their show, and so, as soon as he is off, I dialed it again. And sure enough, Mamie Brown's baby boy Les Brown got me hungry. He answers the phone and we have a great call. We make the connection. I was dreaming it possible. So as soon as that happened, I knew I had to make this reality, I knew I had to do this recording.

So what I want to impart on you, what I want you to understand, is that you do have dreams. Without your dreams, nothing is possible. When you self-doubt, then you start holding back on your dreams, which means, less things are possible for you. So my highest encouragement is just like what it says in the book, dream, then find someone to mentor from, model, take that action, celebrate your success and believe. And of course, then, repeat the first 5 steps. Coz that's it, ladies and gentlemen, think of it like a circle. Visualize me now with my hand doing that circle. Talk about it before. I am going to talk about it again. It is so perfect because of Jane song.

Dream it possible. Dream it possible. So picture my hand at the top, like I am about to go around the circle in a clock. And I have that dream, I have that dream of whatever love I am at. Meaning, whatever love that you are at right now, ladies and gentlemen, no matter what space you are, put a dream in place. From that dream, find that person mentor model, which means my hand now is moving around in the clockwise direction. Maybe it is that 2, 3 o'clock position. From there, take that action, you are now 4 or 5 o'clock position. And then from there, you celebrate your success. 6, 7, 8, position. And from that, you believe in yourself, which means you are now at the 8, 9, 10, 11 position, which because you are believing in yourself, you are now going to set bigger dreams, which lead to you finding bigger mentors to model from, which means you take bigger actions, which means you have bigger celebrations, which means you have more belief in yourself, which again goes to even bigger dreams ladies and gentlemen, and it becomes perpetual motion, perpetual motion, around and around and around again. That is called dreaming it possible.

You don't have to know how it is going to happen. You don't have to know why it is going to happen. Or when it is going to happen. You start with the dreams. You start and then you dream it possible. That is what I am talking about. That is why I was inspired. That is why I want to do this talk. So I did the recording even though I've been on the stage all day, you are worth it. I am worth it. The world is worth it. So that is what I want to say. I want to say thank you again for all the people that is following us on the podcast. Every chance I get, I am going to get on, I am going to record, I am going to give a message, I am going to do what I can to dream it possible for you.

Stick with me. Work with me. Altogether. We can make even the most impossible things come to light. Jane, thank you. She started when her father passed away to sing in night clubs after school, to help pay and raise money for her family just to survive. From there, she lined up with over a hundred fifty thousand people in 2005 to get on that, on the program. From there, she ends up instantly being put on the program, but she doesn't win but since 2005, she has been the star, the sweetheart in China. The voice, you heard it. You understand what I am saying. So that is it for me. As Mamie Brown's baby boy Les Brown would say, that is my story and I am sticking to it. I love Mr. Les Brown.

If you are listening to this Les, I dedicate this episode to you because you help so many people dream it possible by being who you are. Always live with passion. We'll talk to you on the next episode. Thanks everybody!
