I get to change lives. I get to do all of that. And I get to make money doing it. See that's the best of both worlds. So if you haven't discovered

your purpose, your reason for being here, that's the second most important day of your life and I'm gonna encourage you to go and look for it. I'm gonna go and encourage you to just actually go sit, quiet your mind, and connect, be present, and check in with yourself. Ask yourself, what is it I truly enjoy.

Even if I was just to start a part, little bit here and there, little bit now, little bit later, building up what would I really truly love to do, why am I on this planet right now? And then start moving in that direction, start moving towards it. If it's a natural talent. Something you just were born with. Example I've always loved to talk. But I'll tell you what? I've never been a professional speaker until I was thirty two, thirty three.

And I have a lot of self-doubt, I had a lot of reasons why I couldn't do it. So then I learned the skills, I learned skills I needed to be able to enhance the natural talent I already had.
