And so one of the easy ways to get results in 2018—show up, be present and connect with people. Look at them. See them, truly see them. Smile, nod, say hello and be connected.

It may be someone down the road that becomes a friend or a client. Or maybe nothing happens at all, but you never know how you may just impact someone's day.
